

## **LESSON 7—At Home in Galilee**

### **Questions and Answers—Student Guide**

**Lesson goal:** The goal of this lesson is answer the questions, “While Jesus was in Galilee, how did some people show their faith in him, and how did others reject him?”

9. What sin or sins does this lesson teach you to confess?
10. Where do you see the love of God in this lesson?
11. What does God teach you to do in this lesson?

#### **Lead**

12. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

#### **Additional questions**

13. Describe the area of Galilee: its mention in the Old Testament, its history, its connection to Jesus and his life and ministry, its geography, etc.
14. Locate the following places on a map and describe them in regard to Jesus’ life and ministry: the Sea of Galilee, Nazareth, Cana, Capernaum, Bethsaida and Chorazin.
15. What is the Theology of the Cross? How does it compare to the Theology of Glory?

16. Describe the history, layout, and purpose of the synagogue.
