

## **Lesson 4 Student Guide - The First Lord's Supper**

**Lesson Goal:** The goal of this class is to answer this question: "What was the Last Supper?"

**Pre-Lesson Preparation:** Read Matthew 26:17-29 and John 13:31-14:7.

**Think - Get your audience to think about an interesting topic or question.**

1. What is the significance of the Last Supper to believers today?
2. How does Jesus draw a parallel to the Passover lambs in the Old Testament?

**Evaluate - Bring more meaning and context to the lesson.**

3. Who are the characters in this story?
4. What are the objects in this story?
5. Where did this story happen?
6. When did this story happen?
7. What is the problem?
8. What events occurred in this story?
9. Is the problem solved?

**Learn: Identify that sin is the problem and only God has the answer.**

10. What is the main theme of this lesson?
11. What sin does this lesson teach us to confess?
12. Where do you see the love of God in this lesson?
13. What does God teach us to do in this lesson?

**Lead: Share this with a group of your brothers and sisters in Christ.**

14. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

**Additional questions: add depth to the lesson.**

15. Read John 13:1-16. Why did Jesus wash his disciples' feet before the Passover supper?
16. What "communion" happens when we receive this sacrament?
