

## **Lesson 7 Student Guide - Jesus Dies and Is Buried**

Lesson Goal: The goal of this class is to answer this question: "What does Jesus' death and burial mean for us?"

Before class: Read Luke 23:35-56.

**Think** - Get your audience to think about an interesting topic or question:

1. How does the timeline of the past 24 hours for Jesus impact the exhaustion and agony he must endure?
2. What comfort did Jesus give the criminal dying next to him that we also may receive?

**Evaluate** - Bring more meaning and context to the lesson:

3. Who are the characters in this story?
4. What are the objects in this story?
5. Where did this story happen?
6. When did this story happen?
7. What is the problem?
8. What events occurred in this story?
9. Is the problem solved?

**Learn** - Identify that sin is the problem and only God has the answer.

10. What is the main theme of this lesson?
11. What sin does this lesson teach us to confess?
12. Where do you see the love of God in this lesson?
13. What does God teach us to do in this lesson?

**Lead** - Share this with a group of your brothers and sisters in Christ.

14. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

**Additional questions: add depth to the lesson.**

15. What other miraculous events occurred while Jesus was dying on the cross?

16. What did the process of crucifixion include?

17. What does Jesus' death and burial mean for us?
