Lesson Goal: The goal of this class is to answer this question: "What happened after Jesus left the upper room on the night he was betrayed?"

Before class: Read Luke 22:39-62.

Think - Get your audience to think about an interesting topic or question.

1. What can we learn from the disciples in this lesson?
2. How can we learn to act as Christians from Peter's behavior in the courtyard?

Evaluate - Bring more meaning and context to the lesson.

3. Who are the characters in this story?
4. What are the objects in this story?
5. Where did this story happen?
6. When did this story happen?
7. What is the problem?
8. What events occurred in this story?
9. Is the problem solved?

Learn - Identify that sin is the problem and only God has the answer.

10. What is the main theme of this lesson?
11. What sin does this lesson teach us to confess?
12. Where do you see the love of God in this lesson?
13. What does God teach us to do in this lesson?

Lead - Share this with a group of your brothers and sisters in Christ.

14. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

Additional questions: add depth to the lesson.

15. How are we like the disciples in the garden of Gethsemane in regard to our spiritual lives today?

16. How are we like Peter in the courtyard in Luke 22:54-62?
