Lesson Goal

The goal of this class is to answer these questions: “How is the sacrament of Holy Communion powerful?” and “How can we prepare ourselves to receive Holy Communion?”

Pre-Class Preparation

Read 1 Corinthians 10:14-22 and 11:17-33

Think

Why is Holy Communion powerful beyond simply doing something to remember Jesus? Can taking Holy Communion ever be harmful? We will try to answer these questions as we evaluate this section of Paul’s first letter to the Corinthians.

Evaluate

1. Who are the characters in the story?
2. What are the objects in the story?
3. Where did the story happen?
4. When did the story happen?
5. What is the problem?
6. What happened in the story?
7. Is the problem solved?

Learn

8. What is the main theme of the lesson?
9. What sin does this lesson lead you to confess?
10. Where do you see the love of God in the lesson?
11. What does God teach you to do in the lesson?

Lead

12. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

14. How can taking Holy Communion be harmful?
15. Holy Communion strengthens and shows our connection with God. What other connection is made during it?
