Questions and Answers—Student Guide

9. What sin or sins does this lesson teach you to confess?
10. Where do you see the love of God in this lesson?
11. What does God teach you to do in this lesson?

Lead

12. What would be a good situation in which to share this message?

Additional questions

13. List some of the key dates and events in the life of the apostle Paul.

14. Paul wrote more than 25% of the New Testament. The Bible we read today is a translation of what the prophets and apostles wrote in the original languages. What

language was the Old Testament written in? What language was the New Testament written in?

15. When someone wants to do a translation of any book, there are certain guidelines they need to follow and certain requirements they need to meet to have a translation that is true to the original. What are those guidelines and requirements?

16. When choosing a good Bible translation, what are some factors your group or church should consider?

17. Ask the key questions: What message did Paul preach at the synagogue in Pisidian Antioch? How did the people react?
